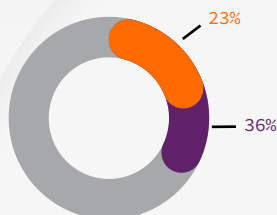


Current state of trauma data

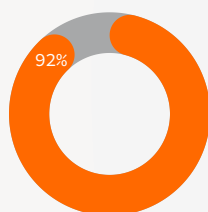
Q-Centrix spoke with trauma professionals to understand **ongoing market challenges, best practices and needs.**

Overall, **36%** of trauma centers are able to capture their data within 2 weeks of patient discharge.

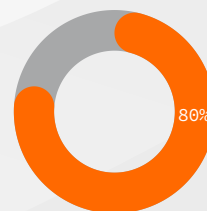


Of the trauma centers capturing data within 2 weeks of discharge, **23%** are capturing in real-time.

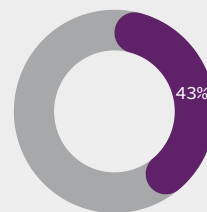
Almost all respondents indicated that they had issues with reporting technology and data concurrency.



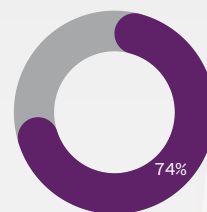
80% of centers had difficulty recruiting and retaining trauma registrars.



Less than half of the participants had the state-required number of registrars.



Three-quarters of participants reported a gap in their trauma education offering for their teams.



› Best practices



Implementing a user-friendly technology to help capture, review, and access data in real-time.



Partnering with a third-party to help staff trauma registries with experienced registrars, allowing other staff to focus on other duties and take pressure off recruitment and retention.

Information was gathered in May - June 2021 with 14 participating trauma centers.
